QUALIFICATIONS

- Attend a Harrison School
 District 2 high school or charter school for at least one full year prior to graduating
- Earn a minimum 2.5 high school GPA (cumulative, or junior/senior year GPA)
- Enroll at PPCC within one year of graduating from high school
- Apply for Financial Aid: Students need to first apply for financial aid programs available to all students. Those funds, if awarded, will be used first. Additional funds to cover tuition and fees will be covered by the Dakota Promise Scholarship.


To continue to receive the Dakota Promise Scholarship, students must:

- Complete a minimum of 24 credit hours each academic year at PPCC
- Stay above a 2.0 GPA at PPCC
- Continue to apply for financial aid each academic year

HOW TO APPLY

- Apply for admission to Pikes Peak Community College: ppcc.edu/apply
- Apply for Financial Aid
 - US citizens and eligible non-citizens apply at FAFSA.gov
 - Non-US citizens not eligible for federal financial aid must apply for Colorado State Aid at ppcc.edu/financial-aid-forms
- Apply for and authorize the College Opportunity Fund (COF): ppcc.edu/cof
- Submit your High School Transcript to PPCC
