Arbor Day is April 26th this year. The idea of Arbor Day sprouted from the mind of a zealous tree lover named Julius Sterling Morton, who had a passion for planting all kinds of trees. He married his wife, Caroline, in Detroit in October of 1854 and headed west to settle 160 acres of treeless land in Nebraska Territory. He planted thousands of trees and fruit trees on his ranch and encouraged others in his prairie state to plant a variety of trees and crops. He served as the Secretary of Agriculture under President Grover Cleveland.

Trees are beneficial to humanity in many ways. They remove particulate matter which is a form of air pollution dangerous to our lungs. Through photosynthesis, trees absorb carbon dioxide. Trees support wildlife, clean our air and water, cool the earth, and help reduce our stress when we take a quiet stroll beneath their shade.


Why not learn a lesson from the trees:
